## **WORSHIP NOTES**

### **Worship Services Online**

Our hope is to livestream our outdoor worship service this Sunday (barring any technical difficulties!). Click [here](#) to find the livestream for our worship services on Facebook (or copy this link and paste it into your browser: <https://www.facebook.com/Covenant-CRC-520064914738965/>). Then click on the "Videos" section on the left hand side. It will say "live" next to it when we are live. Remember, the video will not show up until a few minutes before 10:00 AM. You can also choose to watch a recorded version of the service after it is over (please note that there may be some dead space at the beginning of the video before worship begins).

### **Worship on Sunday Morning**

This Sunday, **July 19**, we plan to join together with our whole church family using the outdoors as our sanctuary. We will once again be worshipping on the south and west side of the big barn at Heritage Village. When you arrive, please follow directions from the parking attendants and the ushers. As we did in June, we plan to reserve some space for people to drive up closer in order to worship from their cars. Tell a parking attendant if you would like to do that. We invite the rest of you to bring blankets or chairs and spread out under the trees and on the lawn...6 feet apart from other families. Ushers will have bulletins with the order of worship. And once again, even though we are outside, we **highly encourage you to wear a mask if you plan to sing**. We know that it's not always comfortable, but we ask it at this time out of love for neighbor. You are again welcome to bring your own picnic lunch or go on a tree walk after the service – it's a great opportunity for some extended outdoor fellowship with your church family. Keep an eye on the weather and dress accordingly. We will email at 9:00 if weather keeps us from meeting outside. In that case, we will simply livestream the service from the sanctuary. And as you've probably heard before, if you have a cough, fever, or shortness of breath, please stay home. If you have questions, please contact Rebecca De Vries. If you are not able to join us in person, we do plan to livestream the service this Sunday, so find it on Facebook Live as usual and worship with us in spirit in your homes using the order of worship in the [bulletin](#) or the [mobile-friendly worship guide](#).
