"Our God is good, and his hands is strong!"

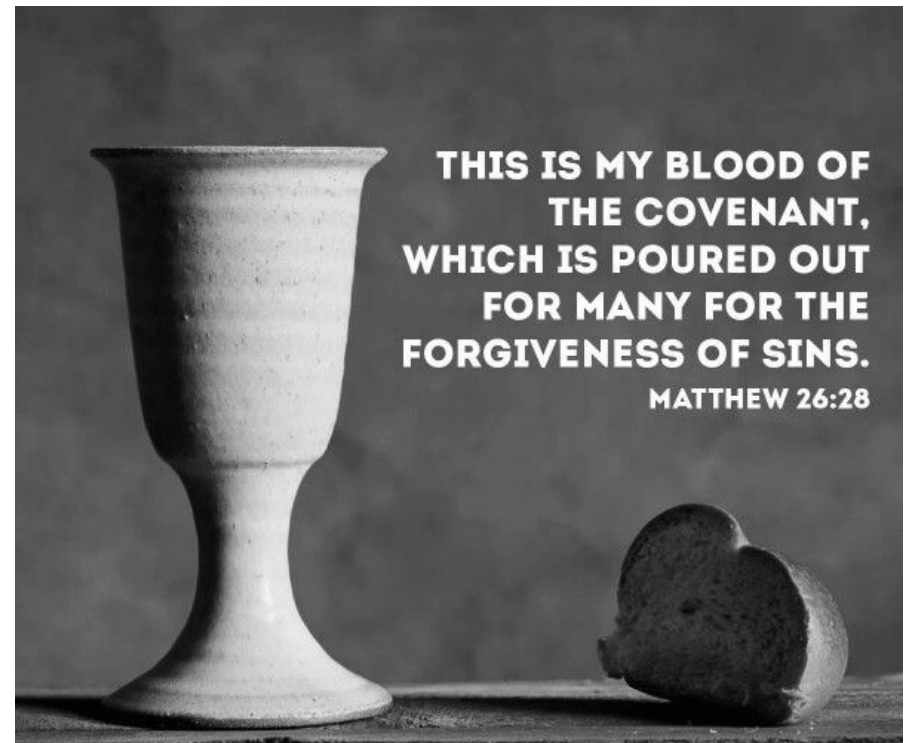
