## **Worship Today**

The Sunday before Easter is an occasion for both joy and sadness. We celebrate with joy as Jesus enters the city of Jerusalem in such a way as to herald his true status as King. Yet our joy is tempered by the knowledge that the week to come brings his betrayal and death. Our worship today is shaped by the impulses of both Palm and Passion Sunday. In this morning's service we focus on the celebration hope of Psalm 118 – the promise that God watches over us and protects us and that we rest secure in God's providential care. This evening, we take a break from our series on Numbers to consider Jesus' triumphal entry and cleansing of the temple as recorded in the Gospel of Matthew, using the evening service to look ahead to the events of Holy Week.

We will gather for worship on Maundy Thursday, **April 13**, at 7:30 PM. Communion will be served and nursery will be provided. Join us again for a brief Good Friday worship service at 12:00 PM on **April 14**.
