# **Worship Services Online**

You can also choose to watch a recorded version of the service after it is over (please note that there may be some dead space at the beginning of the video before worship begins).

### **Worship on Sunday Morning**

This Sunday, **August 23**, we invite you to grab your lawn chairs and blankets and head over to Heritage Village to join together with our whole church family for worship. Keep an eye on the weather and dress accordingly. We will email at 9:00 if weather keeps us from meeting outside. In that case, we will simply livestream the service from the sanctuary.
