### **Note from CHP**

Community Health Partners of Sioux County has seen an increase in illnesses in Sioux County, including influenza, COVID-19, norovirus, strep, and other viruses. McCoy, and now works for the Mary Treglia House in Sioux City helping to resettle Afghan individuals and families.
