Sunday Morning Worship

This Sunday, **April 10**, the sixth Sunday of Lent, is Palm/Passion Sunday. It is a day to remember Christ's triumphal entry into Jerusalem and be mindful that the cries of "Hosanna!" will soon turn to "Crucify him!" We are *remembering* this Lent – this Sunday we remember that Christ reigns – even as he rides on a donkey. And we remember that even if our praises go silent, the stones will cry out to our King. Faith Formation Sunday Evening

This Sunday, **April 10**, we will gather at 6:00 PM for a service of evening prayer, also known as Vespers. These services use prayers and litanies from *The Book of Common Prayer* and give us space and time for thanksgiving and praise, silence, and meditation on scripture. Services last between 45 minutes and an hour and will include a brief meditation. Our Vespers service tonight will include a meditation on Barabbas by Dallas Apol. We will not gather next Sunday evening, **April 17**.

On Good Friday, we will ponder various stations of the cross, combining scripture, prayer, and the artwork of Pastor Sam Gutierrez, a former Covenant member as we worship Jesus as our Crucified and Risen Lord. We encourage you all to join us for these worship services as we look forward to Resurrection Sunday.
