**Friday, March 24:** Dordt University student Julia Holleman will present a senior flute recital at 7:30pm. The recital will feature a variety of instruments, such as harpsicord and cello on Bach's *Sonata IV in C Major* and saxophone with flute performing a recently composed Hymn Suite collection. Another highlight of the recital is an alto flute performance of *Atlantis* by Gary Schocker, which employs the rich overtones of the alto flute to depict swirling water.
