Informational Meeting

Planning for the renovation work is continuing to move along as we get closer to the anticipated construction start date. Here is a short synopsis of the work that has currently been done:

- Currently the sound and AV system design has been completed, approved by council, and equipment is being ordered. The sound and AV systems are within the budget window approved at the congregational meeting with the costs currently at approximately \$82,000.
- The lighting renovation design is being priced by electricians, with the bids on the proposed system due by late October.
- Work is being done with the General Contractor and Architect to address some of the material selections and finishes for the renovation.

We are planning a short meeting after the morning worship service on **October 22** to provide more detailed updates on some of the work listed above and to answer questions about the refresh project. We hope that you will take a few minutes and join us.
